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

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Why Home Educate?

In 1985, as our first child turned five we wanted to continue being as involved with her education and, inspired by books and information published overseas, our family decided to live without school and teach our children from home, joining a small number of like-minded families across Australia. Over the last couple of decades the internet has helped to spread the word and in 2012 an ABC journalist estimated 50,000 children were homeschooling. More recently educator Stuart Chapman calculated that 1% of school age children are registered as home educating students.

The reasons given are as diverse as the individual families choosing it. Parents often revise and add to their original reasons for home educating as the social, academic and developmental benefits accumulate over time.

Home educating parents enjoy experiencing greater influence and control over the direction and content of their children's education. It is only in recent human history that the majority of parents have handed the responsibility of their children's education to schools. Home educating parents report that helping their children learn is a joyous, although at times challenging, task that brings rewards beyond academic education. Learning together as a family builds a wonderful sense of community: this is the foundation for the development of responsible citizenship and healthy, happy and cooperative societies.


The nature of home education allows for incredible flexibility and diversity: parents are able to teach their children to suit their family's values and beliefs; they use resources and materials to suit their individual children's learning needs and styles; and are able to explore and experiment with many different approaches to education. Families evolve their own educational philosophies to suit their own particular circumstances and needs. Home education is a legal alternative to school education across Australia and support networks exist in all regions, providing information (printable brochure) and sharing experiences among home educating families.

Home Education Defined

I was originally introduced to the idea of learning without school as homeschooling. As the concept took hold across Australia many of us adopted the term home education as we felt the word school narrowed people's understanding of what we were doing with our children. Education is a broader concept than school and many of us find that the regulating authorities still take the concept of school within the word homeschool too literally. In reality the practice is different: it is difficult and not necessarily desirable to replicate school within the home and most of us don't.

Back in the 1980s when we started most people confused homeschooling with correspondence school (now referred to as distance education). In recent years the term unschooling, which describes a particular philosophical approach to the education of children, has been used by the media and is being widely and interchangeably used with the term homeschooling. I personally prefer using the term home education, and describe us as 'educating parents'. The internet and information technology blurs the distinction between distance and online education, and home educating students now access a much wider range of resources, including (in some instances) part-time enrolment in schools and colleges. However, I'll take a moment to define the various terms as it can be helpful, especially when we are joining local and online support groups.

Home education is personally taking responsibility for and control of your children's education personally instead of delegating it to a school or teacher. It is a legal alternative to school based education with home education registration processes available in every state and territory in Australia. You can select from a huge range of pedagogical approaches and learning materials and resources. There are two main styles of home education: homeschooling and unschooling. Both make



use of a variety of educational resources, including online learning, distance education, tutoring, community classes, group learning and more.

Homeschoolers more or less adopt many of the teaching practices and resources found in classrooms and used by teachers. They follow the general outline of the national curriculum or state syllabus, teaching children in much the same way, and following the scope and sequence within the curriculum, as school teachers do. They structure their children's day to accommodate discrete lessons or activities covering specific content within each subject. However, most homeschooled students are much more involved in the selection of content and activities and have a greater say in the direction and approach to education than their schooled peers.

Unschooling goes further than homeschooling: it is a rejection of the traditional reasons for schooling children as well as the methods used to educate them; in particular the segmenting of learning into chunks and teaching it according to a set timetable. Unschooling trusts in children's innate natural learning ability with parents facilitating supported self-directed learning opportunities. Instead of teaching children in a prescribed manner, unschoolers help them learn what they need to learn in order to grow and develop. It's much more than an approach to the education of children, it's a way of life.

You may hear **unschooling** and **natural** or **life learning** used interchangeably. Natural learning is simply celebrating the fact that everyone learns all the time, and that by reflecting on the processes by which we learn we can become more focused






Beginning with the assumption that, having considered your reasons and options carefully, you have decided to take full responsibility for your children's education, my aim is to lead you through the steps necessary to successfully begin and continue your home educating adventure.

Through the information here, I hope to help you feel more confident about your ability to provide your children with an excellent education, tailored to their unique and individual learning needs. Rather than add to the myriad of curriculum resources available for home educated children to use, my aim is to help demystify the learning and teaching process and to remind parents of their natural ability to help their children learn. I am continually adding to my range of e-books and encourage you to visit The Educating Parent and Always Learning Books regularly to see what's new.

On <u>The Educating Parent</u> you will a huge list of articles I've written over three decades to encourage and support parents to educate their children. We officially started home educating our eldest in early 1986, using a school-at-home approach, basing it on her kindergarten experiences and what we remembered from our own school life. We'd actually been educating her in a hands-on way since her birth six years before. Gradually, influenced by the writing of John Holt, Raymond Moore, Alfie Kohn and others, we relaxed into an unschooling, natural learning lifestyle.

Even though I am not qualified as a teacher, my confidence as an educator is derived from approaching the education of my children as a teacher would: I conscientiously planned, recorded and evaluated their educational programs. As a learner I value the tools of observation, reflection and goal setting. These stood me in good stead and I know they will be of immeasurable value to you as you educate your children.

It is easy to go out and purchase a box of books or sign up to an online curriculum and sit your child down and say "you are now a homeschooler, learn". It is a different thing to be an effective educator, meeting and responding to your child's unique learning styles and needs. As a home educator you need to be there with your child, observing how she learns, what she already knows, what she needs to know next, helping her to make sense of and understand the world about her. The need for tests and exams to measure her progress is reduced or eliminated as you help your child understand the ups and downs of the learning process, how learning happens

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for her, and how she can help that happen more effectively.

We can be passive home educators or we can be active learners, learning alongside our children, enjoying every minute of their educational journeys. The Educating Parent is dedicated to helping you become the latter. I want you to be a hands-on parent because being and doing that has brought us incredible joy. We are now helping our children home educate their children and enjoying a special relationship and connection with our grandchildren that is immensely rewarding.

As parents Robin and I are not exceptional people: we don't have tertiary education qualifications and our work experience is limited to clerical and retail jobs. What probably sets us apart is our do-it-yourself attitude to life which helped to develop a vast range of different skills in many areas of life. We describe ourselves as active learners who look forward to what each new day brings. Self-reliance and self-confidence were high on our list of priorities for our children as young parents. Home educating hasn't always been easy but it has always been rewarding. We are richer in many ways because we trod this path.

When we started out on our home educating journey we were not perfect parents: far from it! How we parented and educated our children looked very different in those early years to how it looked a decade down this path, and how we interact with our grandchildren now. We have learned an enormous amount along the way. Some lessons were learned by observing how our children and other children learn. We listened carefully when people have shared their stories with us and we've learned from their lessons too. As far as possible we continually adapted what we were doing in the light of new understanding and knowledge. And that is the nature of home education: flexible and adaptable!

Home education offers parents the opportunity to give their children a high quality education that is responsive to the child, parent, family and community. It is an education option that is truly accountable. You get out of it what you put into it: the more attention, time and energy you invest into planning, recording and evaluating your home educating experience the greater the reward and sense of satisfaction you will achieve.



Getting Ready to Home Educate

Before you worry about how to legally register as a home educating family (see the next section) there are a few things you need to consider. I've added links to further reading, a selection of articles from the many on my website: bookmark them to read later. Approach

What kind of education do you want? Homeschooling and unschooling are fundamentally different to schooling. School is classroom oriented whereas home education is family and community oriented. Getting out and about is an important aspect of our educational lives. Your children know the difference between parenting and teaching. You'll save yourself time, money and energy to spend a few moments thinking about what kind of education you want for your children. It isn't about how many hours of instruction you provide each day, it is about being able to offer quality individualised learning programs tailored to suit your children's unique learning needs.

You will need to design your own learning plans, loosely based around the Australian Curriculum or syllabus used by your state or territory education system. Home educators are on their own, no funding or resources are provided by the state, and this is why there are so many <u>online support groups!</u>

A Learning Plan: your child's curriculum

Writing your own learning plan isn't difficult once you've determined what the children need to learn. Begin by developing your own personal philosophy or mission statement about education: this will give you a solid foundation that will help to build confidence as an educating parent. Home educators are able to use any of the many different educational philosophies and resources—and there are many! Learning Environment and Resources

After mapping out a rough plan, finding appropriate resources to help your children learn is the next exciting step! It will take time to find the methods and materials that work best for you and your family. There is no right or wrong way to home educate your children. The first couple of years will include lots of experimenting with different approaches and resources. All families go through this settling in stage. Eventually you and your child will work out which resources and approaches are

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most responsive to his or her learning needs. Support

Everyone experiences these things differently so it is useful to talk to as many families as you can. Subscribe to any home educating newsletters and magazines that you come across, many are free. And don't be shy: ask questions. People have 'been there and done that' before you and can help.

Registering: State Information

Home education is recognised as a legal alternative to school-based education in all states and territories within Australia. Although the benefits are many, commitment is essential. Getting approval isn't the hurdle it used to be but it does require some thinking and effort. Expect to spend a few weeks researching different resources and approaches you can use while putting together your learning plan for your children.

• Is Homeschooling Legal? Getting Approval to Home Educate in Australia

It is important to note that 'education', not 'schooling', is compulsory:

"That every child has a right to an education is recognised in international instruments such as the United Nations Universal Declaration on Human Rights (UDHR) (1948) and the Convention on the Rights of the Child (CROC) (1990) to which Australia is a signatory. The UDHR provides that 'education shall be free, at least in the elementary and fundamental stages' [and] that 'elementary education shall be compulsory...'; and that 'parents have a prior right to choose the kind of education that shall be given their children' (Article 26(3)). CROC also provides that 'states parties shall take all appropriate measures to ensure that the child is protected against all forms of discrimination or punishment on the basis of the status, activities, expressed opinions, or beliefs of the child's parents, legal guardians, or family members.' (CROC, Article 2(2))."

Not all home educating families agree with the way state educational authorities interpret the laws and regulations regarding education. Some families believe that the conditions imposed on them by bureaucracy are fair and reasonable, but others argue they are unnecessary and intrusive. You will need to think carefully about your own values and do what sits comfortably within your family beliefs, lifestyle and conscience. We personally found the process of investigating the legal ramifications of home education an empowering one. Once we knew and understood our responsibilities we felt more confident about our choice, and that helped us defend it to people who questioned our decision.

There are penalties for not complying with the law and these penalties are detailed in the state and territory Education Acts (see links below). If a family is found to be not complying, they are either required to immediately enrol their children at school or register as home educators. Most families usually comply and register without invoking a penalty. It is unusual for court action to occur on the basis of education provision alone: but does occur if there is suspicion of neglect of the child's welfare.

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Before you start preparing your application to register join a <u>local or state support</u> group and ask people to share their experiences with you. Legislation and regulations differ from state to state and local up-to-date knowledge is especially important in helping you successfully complete your application. Most states require evidence of court orders where custody is an issue, and some require both natural parents to sign the home education application.

Read through the relevant sections in the Education Act and any government information about registering thoroughly. If you are unsure of any of the legal aspects, by all means chat to local home educators, but if yours is an unusual situation don't hesitate to seek advice from legal aid or a lawyer.

Some regulatory bodies have a vested interest in retaining your child's enrolment at school, and sometimes officers reviewing your situation have a limited understanding of the nature of home education, especially if they are new to the position. Understanding your rights and responsibilities will ensure you are not intimidated into giving up your goal of home educating your children. This may not be the intention of the authorising body, but it could easily become the result.

Generally speaking, the home educating regulatory authorities need assurance that the children will receive a quality education aligned with the national curriculum or state syllabus, in an environment that adequately and appropriately meets the developmental, social and learning needs of the child. It is expected that you will keep records of your child's educational activity and the resources used. Home education registration is usually renewed annually, with most states requiring a review report and / or interview.

The application is variously known as 'registration', 'dispensation', and 'obtaining exemption from attending school' depending on where you live. Officers assessing the application and reviews are called 'home education officers', 'moderators' or 'approved persons (Aps)'.

The type of information sought by the authorities varies, but the focus should be on the quality of the proposed learning plan and environment. Be firm and assert that it is the learning plan that is under consideration, not the child's current educational abilities and understandings. As the home educator it is your responsibility to monitor the educational and developmental progress of your child not the office giving permission for you to home educate. Some authorities require more detail than others which is why it is important to seek local knowledge when applying.

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Remember you are an 'educating parent': officers processing your application will feel less inclined to treat you as just 'another parent' if you approach your application in a serious and business-like manner. File records of any communication, including copies of emails and letters, together with detailed notes of any telephone conversations where you can easily find them. Insist of written (emailed) confirmation of details discussed over the phone. A 'paper trail' encourages everyone to remain accountable and respectful. If your state requires a home interview, ask for an outline of what will be discussed to be sent to you at least a week beforehand to enable you to prepare and have on hand what is required. It is possible to gain access to the reports written following home education interviews through the Freedom of Information Act. Keep records of home education registration until the child is past compulsory schooling age.

You don't need to be alone during the home interview, you can have a friend present to help you look after the children, take notes and reduce your anxiety. Let the authority know beforehand you'll have a friend present.

It will help if you **start recording your child's education** as soon as you decide that you are going to home educate. You don't need to wait until you are officially approved. Maintaining some kind of record of our children's learning helps to build our confidence as home educators. It can be as simple as a diary with dated entries marking the days our children do educational activities (the equivalent of a school roll book). Dated records are also legal evidence that your children are being appropriately educated.

Prepare a basic learning plan for the year ahead, perhaps using dot points under the required subject areas. The <u>Australian Curriculum</u> list the following subjects:

- English
- Mathematics
- Science
- Health and Physical Education
- Humanities and Social Sciences: HASS (years F-6/7); History (years 7-10); Geography (years 7-10); Civics and Citizenship (years 7-10); Economics and Business (years 7-10)
- The Arts: Dance, Drama, Media Arts, Music, Visual Arts
- Technologies: Design and Technologies, Digital Technologies
- Languages (other than English)

The Australian Curriculum has been either adopted as is, or incorporated into state syllabi. It makes it easier for the authorities to assess your application if you use terminology with which they are familiar, but you can create your own list of subjects or describe your learning plan in any way you prefer. Remember to mention that you use either the Australian or your state's syllabus as a guide.

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When **preparing your learning plan**, for each subject area think about what your child will be developmentally and educationally ready to learn over the coming year, and create some activities or projects / unit studies around that. Base these your child's level, ability, learning needs, preferences and style. You may wish to add some student workbooks, textbooks or online learning programs, as well as other resources (also known as people, places, things!) Can you build some activities around personal or family interests, hobbies and chores? Most can be easily related to one or more curriculum subjects. Add them in too!

Keep it simple, keep it basic! There is no need to write reams: most of us go way overboard when we write our first home education learning plan. We worry about covering everything our child needs to learn, but it is like most things in life: as we travel along the path the detail becomes visible, we fill in the gaps, or switch focus or direction. To give you an idea of what is normally expected there is a list of examples of approved learning plans on The Educating Parent.

During the home interview you can ask for advice or where to find appropriate resources: the officer conducting the interview will have considerable teaching experience and should have lots of ideas. Even if they don't view their job as such, you can view them as someone there to help you build an excellent education for your child, rather than someone there to judge you, your child or your home.

And remember: your learning plan is only a plan, it isn't set in concrete and is likely to change quite a bit by the end of your first month! The authorities understand this too. Your end of year report doesn't have to look anything like your initial plan. And that's true for families who have been home educating for years as well as beginners: life happens and we will naturally take advantage of whatever educational opportunity or resources come our way throughout the year.

Jotting down a few notes about your children's learning should only take a few minutes several times a day. It is okay to try different approaches to keeping records until you find one you're happy to use on a regular basis. If you are looking for a ready-made recording system, consider the <u>Always Learning Planner</u>, <u>Diary and Reports</u> available from Always Learning Books. Recording make it easier to put together your annual review as well as tweaking your learning plan along the way.

Your home educating records belong to you and your children: never give away original documents or children's work. If samples are required, photocopy and forward them later. For more information about ways to record and evaluate your children's learning visit <u>The Educating Parent</u> website.

Make sure to make it obvious in your application and home interview that you have support from other home educators: leave a copy of your local homeschool newsletter, or HEN's Otherways magazine on display and mention membership of

local and online support groups.

And most of all, don't stress too much. If your plan isn't approved, ask them to tell you what is missing so you can amend your application. Don't accept 'no' as an answer. Negotiate and seek to solve any problems that have arisen. Most states have an appeals process: ask how you can appeal the decision. Some home educators have also requested to be assessed by a different home education officer.

Focus is always placed on <u>socialisation</u> and adequate provision for contact with peers. It is a myth that home educated children are less socialised than school children. In most situations, home education broadens the children's social sphere by removing them from school. Social activities include regular interaction with people from all age groups. Families list cultural, religious, sport and personal interest social activities, as well as participation in home education group activities and camps. A photo album showing incidences of group interaction may help.

Most applications for home education registration are approved. There are processes to appeal should you be declined, and to ensure your application covers everything it needs to it helps to seek advice from <u>local home educating families</u> before applying.

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Withdrawing your Child from School

You may withdraw your child from school at any time, however there are several things you will need to consider.

Private schools usually require payment of fees in advance and withdrawing may incur a financial penalty in addition to loss of any term fees already paid. Read the information on the school's website or the enrolment contract you originally signed. You can ask for a reimbursement of fees from a public school if you are withdrawing close to the beginning of the school year but it is not usual and may be refused as the money may have already been allocated to resources.

You will also need to consider if your child is receiving any special attention or classes through the school by third parties (such as speech pathologists): your child may no longer be eligible to continue with the program and the provider may need to be notified separately.

Advise the school's principal by letter of your intention to home educate your child. Keep a copy and a record of when the letter was posted: send it by registered mail if you anticipate problems. If you use email, request a reply acknowledging receipt of your email. In your communication inform the principal that you have applied to home educate your child and include the contact information of the regulatory authority. You do not need to state your reasons to the school other than to say you will be home educating the child.

Plan ahead if you can. Get your home education learning plan, materials and resources ready, prepare your home and set up any necessary record keeping regime. Many families typically choose the school holidays as a time to prepare, and inform the school on the last day of term. Registering generally takes between 2-4 weeks, sometimes longer at the end and beginning of the school year.

Some schools are considerate and understanding, some offer resources and help, but most react with varying degrees of indifference or hostility. Being prepared for any outcome is useful. Talking to other home educating families about their experiences, especially those who live in your general area, is usually very helpful.

Make a clean break: choose a date for your children to leave the school and work to have your application and letters received by the authority and principal before then. On the last school day collect any books and materials that belong to your child. Return all school property, library books, class sets, sports gear and so on. This is not the time to get into protracted conversations with teachers, staff and other parents about your decision. Record in your home educating diary or calendar that

you have commenced home educating on the day your children were withdrawn from school.

Withdrawal from a public school may be followed by contact from the Education Department truancy section. If you receive a phone call reassure the caller that your children are being educated at home and ask them to set their concerns out in a letter. If you receive an unannounced visit, reassure them that you are educating your children from home and ask for them to set out their concerns in writing. Only invite them into your home after the appropriate process to make a mutually agreed upon appointment has occurred and you are fully prepared.

The normal course of events is for families to seek information about home educating from the regulatory authority (see previous links) as well as home education websites and support groups. After gathering information prepares the registration application and then contact the school to inform the school that the application has been sent. In some states provisional registration is automatic, in other states the school principal can grant an exemption from attending school while the application for home education is being approved and in some it is expected the child will remain in school until registration is granted.


In practice, however, most children are withdrawn from school before the application is finalised and approval given. In some instances where the children's health and well-being is at risk by staying at school parents usually approach their family doctor for a certificate covering the child's absence from school.

The information and advice in this section may seem onerous and, in places overbearing and unnecessary, but by following it closely you may avoid some of the hassles that a few home educating families in the past have endured. Diligence and preparation will pay dividends as you prepare to home educate. This approach will also bolster your confidence at this crucial time.

A Typical Home Educating Day

As home educators we are free to create our own daily schedules. How one family home educates is usually completely different to another: we each find our own routines and rhythms based around what works for each family member.

The following presents a naturally balanced home educating curriculum and can easily cover learning across all subjects. However, there is really no such thing as a 'typical' day, all days are different and that's okay.

- Arise, make beds, prepare and eat breakfast
- Completion of morning chores: personal, household, and animals
- Study: daily focus on maths and language based activities drawn from children's learning plans (about 1-2 hours)
- Snack and stretch
- Work on ongoing project, unit study, art, craft, etc
- Lunch: prepare, eat and clean away after
- Shared or individual reading
- Study: time to pursue personal interests and hobbies
- Outside physical activity: sport, walking, swimming, playing, tree climbing, etc
- Music lesson or practice
- Afternoon chores: personal, household, and animals
- Help prepare and eat dinner, clean away after
- News and current affairs, discussion and conversation
- Watching television, playing educational and fun games, use of computer for games or projects, quiet reading
- Story time
- Ready for bed

Not every day will look like this: some days will be taken up by field trips or excursions, visits to friends or home educating group activities. Other days will be spent focussing on particular projects either as individuals or as a family. Some days the children will play all day, absorbed in whatever game they are playing. Other days will be more structured. Recording what we notice our children doing, and spending time chatting to them, helps to reassure us that they are learning something all the time.





HOME ED CONSULTANTS

With the current exodus from mainstream education by teachers and families, please be aware that there are a lot of new start up businesses marketing themselves to home educators. Some are offering "learning at home" / "remote learning" set ups similarly to what was offered by schools during lockdowns. Others are putting together curriculum packages, or simply charging for writing learning programs for registration purposes.

Many of these have little to no home education experience, and don't realise that home ed doesn't need to look like school, and more often than not, looks NOTHING like school. They may have classroom experience, they may be qualified educators, but they don't know your kids. Furthermore each state has different requirements for home ed registration, and as an example, a school teacher from NSW isn't going to have a good understanding of the requirements to home educate in the NT. We encourage any teachers new to home ed to home educate their own children for a minimum of one year before marketing their services to home educators. And frankly one year is baby steps.

We're not saying that these options aren't good opportunities for home educators, we're suddenly spoiled for choices, but they aren't necessarily going to understand how your family needs to home educate. You're not an expert, but you know your kids, and you've been educating them since birth.

If you are looking at employing the services of one of these many new homeschooling businesses try searching for the person offering their services in the homeschool group/s they are advertising and spruiking their services within. Have they been a member for a few months or a few years? Have they contributed in any meaningful way to other posts, and without trying to sell themselves within the comment? Are they truly a part of the homeschooling community, or do they only see us as an easy target market?

If you do want to seek the help of a consultant to help with planning and registration take a look at the list of consultants below, all have years of experience home educating their own children, and many are trained teachers also.
